

On Friday, September 8th nationally recognized speaker and writer Daniel Mattson will be speaking at St. John the Beloved Parish about the Catholic Church's teaching on same-sex attraction. His talk will be at 7:30 p.m. in the Parish Hall

Daniel Mattson lives in the Midwest, where he has a career in the performing arts. He is a member of the Courage Apostolate and featured is in the documentary Desire of the Everlasting Hills. He has written about the Church's good news concerning homosexuality in First Things, Crisis Magazine, Catholic Answers Magazine as well as other publications. He is also a regular contributor to Chastity.com. He is a frequent guest on Catholic radio, appearing often on Catholic Answers Live, the Al Kresta Show and Catholic Connection with Teresa Tomeo. He has been a featured speaker at the National Catholic Singles Conference, and recently debated the Church's teaching on homosexuality at Bowling Green State University. Daniel has recently published a book titled "Why I Don't Call Myself Gay: How I Reclaimed My Sexual Reality and Found Peace" which has been endorsed by Rev. Paul Scalia and will be available for purchase at his talk.
