### ST. JOHN ACADEMY LIBRARIAN

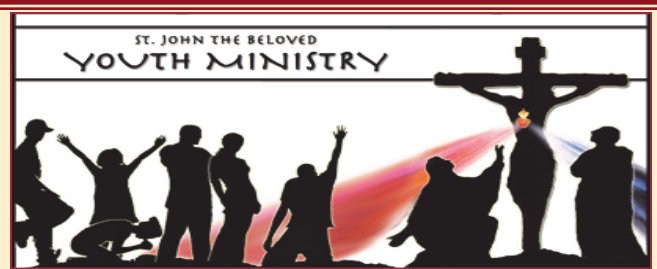

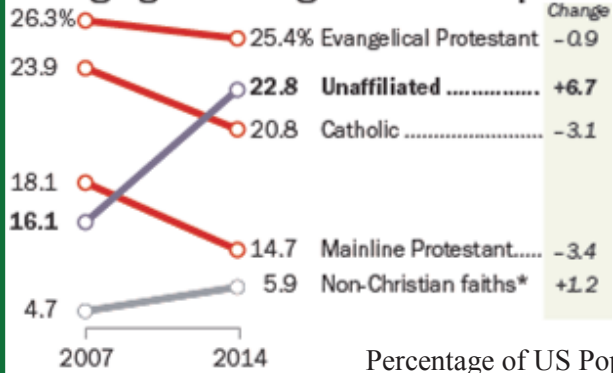
