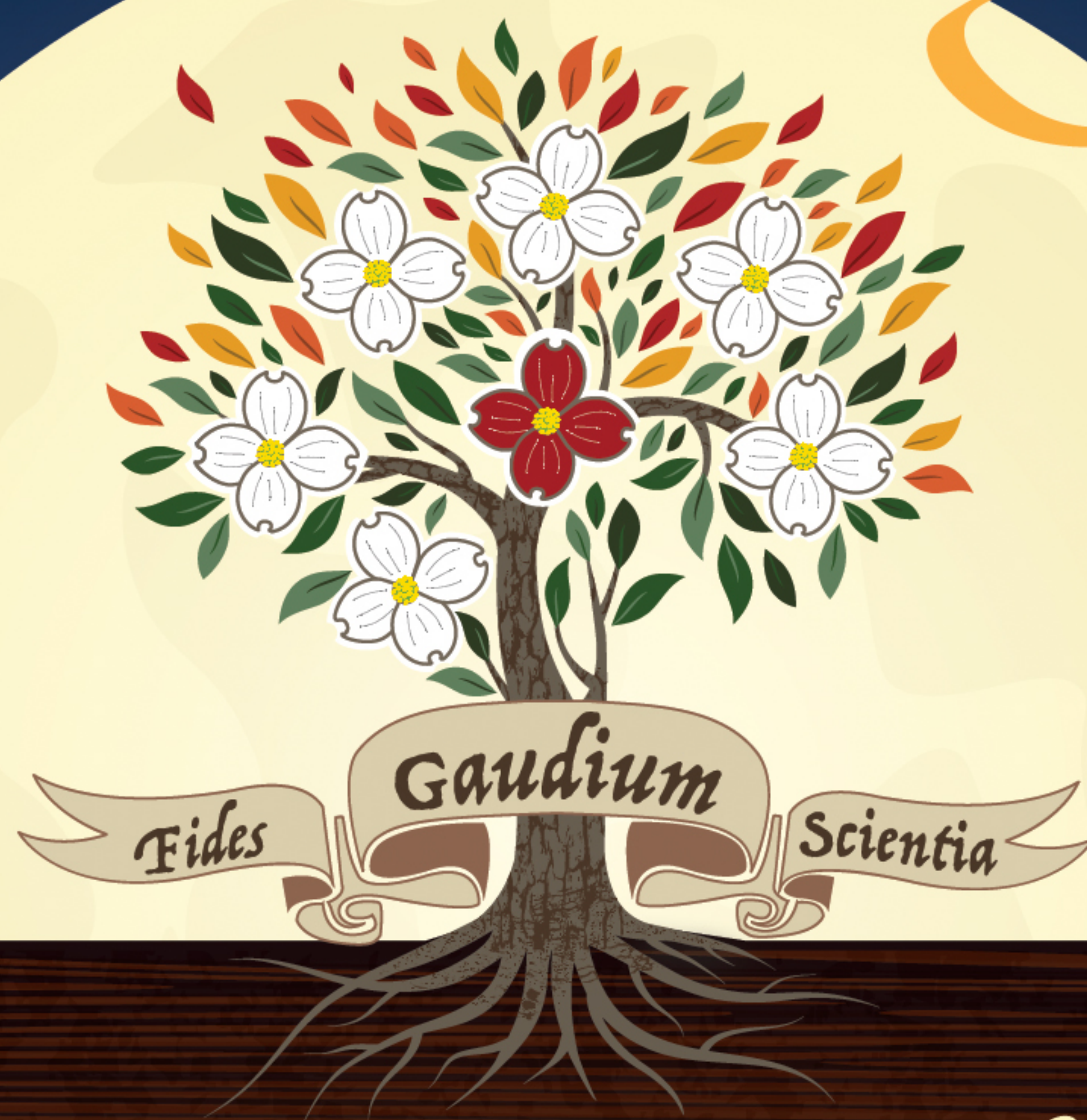
### PRO ANIMIS SANCTIS IN PURGATORIO

**KEY DATES FOR THE 2023 ELECTIONS**

*Friday, September 22, 2023* - First day of in-person early voting at your local registrars office In-person early voting is highly encouraged this year!

*October 16, 2023* - Deadline to register to vote or update an existing registration. (Voters may register after this date, through Election Day, and vote using a provisional ballot).

*October 27, 2023* - Deadline to apply for a ballot to be mailed to you. Your request must be received by your local voter registration office by 5:00 p.m.

*Saturday, October 28, 2023* - Voter registration offices open for early voting.

*Saturday, November 4, 2023* - at 5:00 p.m. The last day of in-person early voting at your local voter registration office. <https://vote.elections.virginia.gov/voterInformation/PublicContactLookup>
