EUCCHARISTIC HOLY HOUR

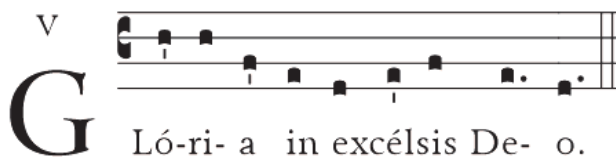

CHRIST HOUSE EVENING MEAL CO-COORDINATOR

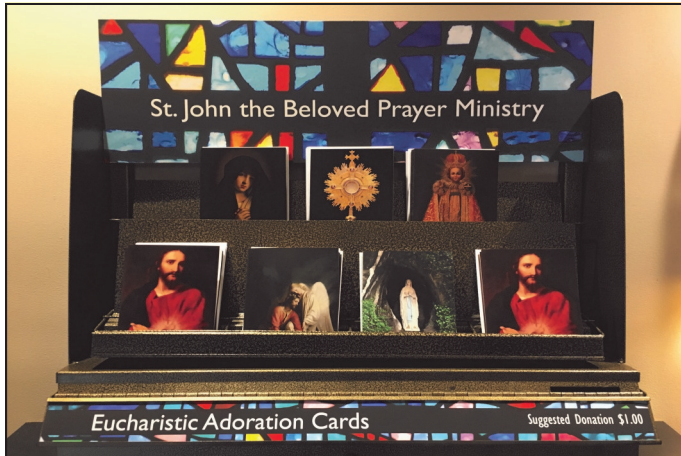

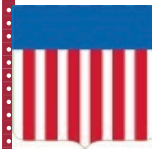
