

FROM THE DESK OF THE SEMINARIAN ...

Dear Parishioners of St. John the Beloved,

Allow me to introduce myself. My name is Daniel Reuwer, and I will be assigned to the parish as a seminarian this summer. I am blessed to be discerning for the Diocese of Arlington, especially since my time in the diocese has been relatively short.

I am the oldest of six children, with the youngest being 7 years old.

My Dad worked for the government, so growing up we always moved around, living in multiple states in the US as well as in England and Italy. Upon graduating high school in the Chesapeake, VA area, I attended Belmont Abbey College near Charlotte, NC, where I graduated with degrees in Theology and Government. After college I moved to Stafford, VA. St. William of York, the local parish, has since become my home parish here in the diocese.

Before entering seminary, I worked as a teacher at St. William of York Catholic School. There I taught religion and social studies in the middle school, and was the teacher in charge of the sixth-grade homeroom. Additionally, I was the Athletic Director, and helped to coach baseball and soccer.

After two years of teaching, I felt called to pursue a vocation to the priesthood. Working in a parochial school had given me the desire to serve God's Church as a parish priest. Upon applying to become a seminarian, I was accepted and assigned to study at St. Charles Borromeo Seminary in Philadelphia. Earlier this summer I completed my first year as a student in Pre-Theology, and I will be headed back there to continue in the Fall.

One of the best parts of seminary so far has been our Apostolate experience. On Thursdays, we were sent to different places near the seminary to gain hands-on pastoral experience. I was assigned to a parish in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia and greatly appreciated the variety of experiences at the parish.

I am really looking forward to serving the parish family here at St. John the Beloved for the next couple of months, and further gaining a variety of different pastoral experiences. Know that you all have been in my prayers, and please keep me in yours as well. I look forward to meeting you all soon.
