ADORERS ARE NEEDED ON WEDNESDAYS

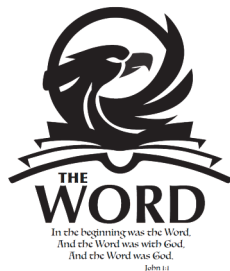
