Just as the Apostles who, having just witnessed Our Lord's Ascension, "returned to Jerusalem with great joy, and were continually in the temple blessing God" (Luke 24, 52-53) and then "devoted themselves to prayer, together with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brethren" (Acts 1,14), obediently observing Our Lord's command to "stay in the city, until you are clothed with power from on high" (Luke 24,48), we shall join in prayer to accompany our fellow Christians as they approach the Holy Sacrament of Confirmation and beg the Lord to make equally joyful, prayerful, and obedient so that the Holy Spirit will find them receptive to the Sanctifying Grace that will operate in them and through them for the salvation of souls.
