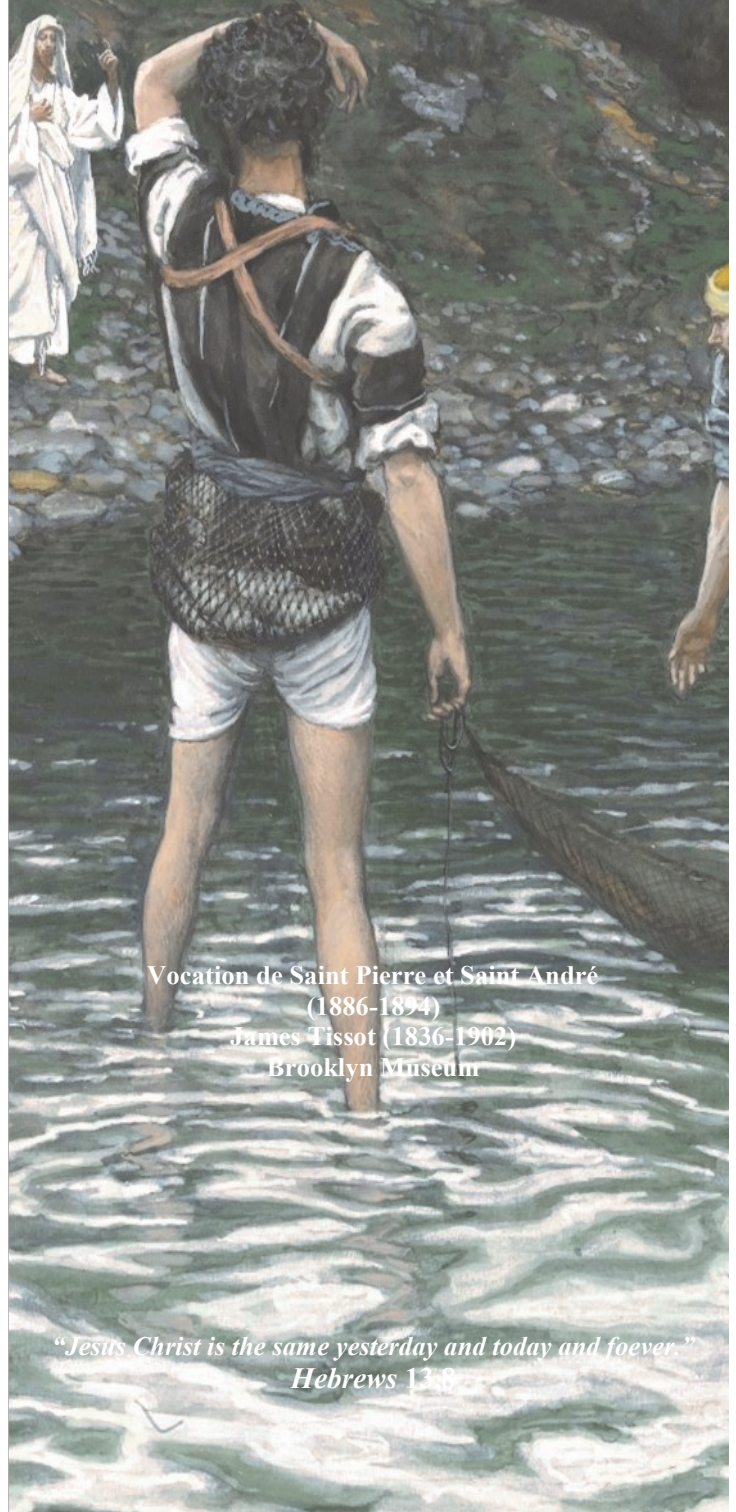

 expenses. Since the recipient is 22 years old the  
 preferred donor age is between 21 and 49. However  
 doctors are allowing older candidates to be tested  
 since the finding of such a qualifying living donor  
 could make available the needed transplant through  
 the Paired Kidney Exchange.
