# Opportunities in Sacred Music

## Saint John Parish Choir

The Saint John Parish Choir is a mixed choir (soprano, alto, tenor and bass; SATB) of adults and older youth in grades 9 - 12. The SJPC sings weekly for the 10:30 a.m. Sunday Mass and rehearses each Wednesday from 7:00 - 8:30 p.m. A basic knowledge of music and/or experience in choral singing is recommended, but not required.

## Beloved Choir

The Beloved Choir is a choir of treble voices in grades 3 - 8. The BC sings weekly for the 9:00 a.m. Sunday Mass. Girls rehearse each Monday and Wednesday morning from 7:30 - 8:15 a.m.; Boys rehearse each Tuesday and Thursday morning. A Tuesday evening rehearsal from 5:45 - 6:30 p.m. is available for those who are unable to attend the morning rehearsals.

## Saint Gregory Choir

The Saint Gregory Choir is a mixed choir of professional and semi-professional singers. The SGC sings weekly for the 12:00 Mass in the Extraordinary Form and rehearses each Thursday from 7:30 - 9:30 p.m. An audition is required.



## Organ and Instrumentalists

According to Vatican II, “the pipe organ is to be held in high esteem, for it is the traditional musical instrument which adds a wonderful splendor to the Church’s ceremonies and powerfully lifts up man’s mind to God and to higher things.” (*Sacrosanctum Concilium*) Those who play a string, woodwind, or brass instrument are invited to participate during solemnities such as Christmas and Easter.

## Sacred Music Apprenticeship Program

The Sacred Music Apprenticeship Program provides musical and liturgical education students who wish to serve at Mass through their music. The apprenticeship offers two tracks: cantor and organist. In both tracks, students receive regular formal instruction in the theology, history, music and planning of the liturgy as well as practical experience assisting at the liturgy. Graduates of the Apprenticeship will understand their spiritual and practical role in the liturgy, have the knowledge to plan and lead music for the liturgy, and be well-poised to continue further instruction if they so wish.

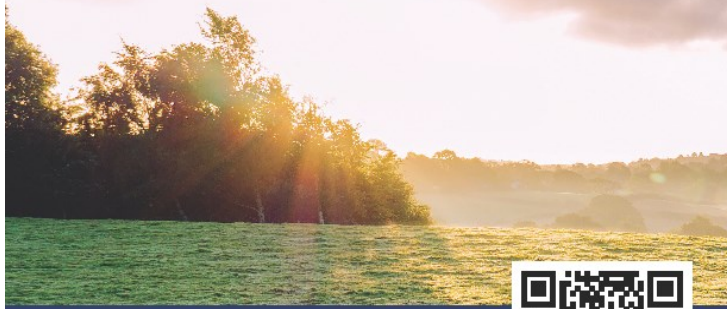
