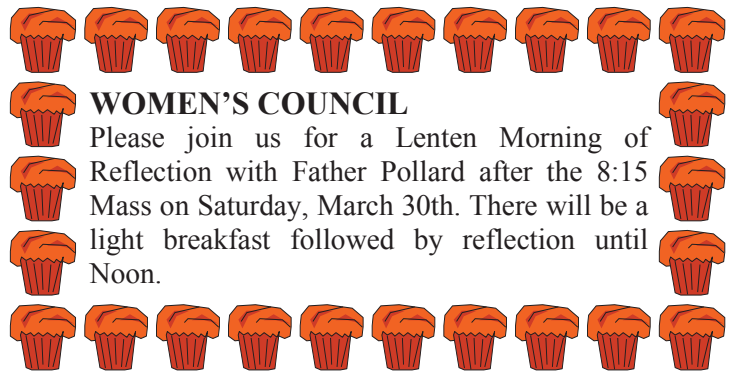

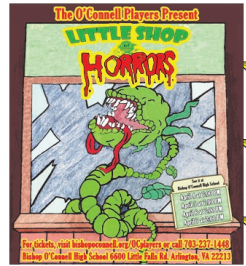

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

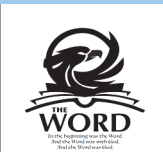
