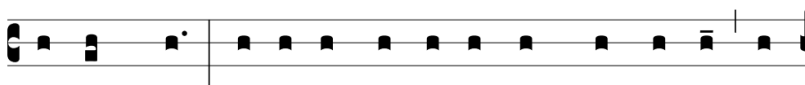

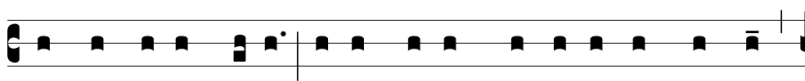

For their guidance hath he made.

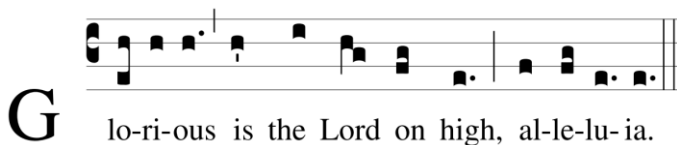
