

But now the bands of death are burst, The ransom has been paid; And thou art on thy Father's throne In majesty arrayed.


O may thy mighty love prevail Our sinful souls to spare, O may we come before thy throne And find acceptance there.

1 Peter 3:18,22



Lord Jesus, you are the King of glory.


Where you have gone before us in glory, —may we follow you in mind and heart.
